Please don't forget to send the children with an egg to decorate on Monday, we always look forward to seeing what they create.

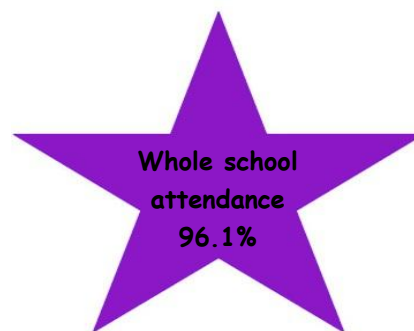
### **Non-uniform Day**
