### Gateshead School Sports Partnership - Year 3/4 Quadkids Athletics

On Wednesday, we took 2 teams of 10 children from years 3 and 4 to Kingsmeadow School for the Quadkids Athletics event. All the children took part in 4 events: 50m sprint, vortex howler throw, 400m run and standing long jump.

Miss Holmes and I were both very impressed by the perseverance and determination our children showed. They kept trying their best with each event all the way up to the finish line! We were also wowed by how supportive they were of each other; they cheered each other on and congratulated each other. We also spotted them congratulating children from other schools. They demonstrated fantastic sportsmanship!

Throughout the morning their behaviour was impeccable and without being prompted, they all thanked the bus driver when we got back to school.

Last but not least, they did really well with their athletics. At the end of the morning all the teams' scores were added up and we waited with bated breath to find out where we had come. Emmaville Team B did incredibly well and scored 1,646 points, coming 6th out of 21 teams! Then it came to the top 3 to be announced. We crossed our fingers and many of the children shut their eyes. We weren't 3rd, we weren't 2nd... then 1<sup>st</sup> place was announced... it was Emmaville Team A with a total of 1,906 points! We were all delighted and cheered as Team A went up to be awarded their gold medals.

Our event was for Gateshead West schools and on Thursday 8th June it will be Gateshead East's event. The 2 highest scoring teams will qualify through to the County Finals! We are keeping everything crossed and waiting to find out whether we have made it through.

Miss Holmes and I were incredibly proud of our wonderful children today; not only because of their achievements, but because of their fantastic behaviour and wonderful attitude. Go Team Emmaville!


